



## Garden Operating Protocols for Plot Holders: Covid-19

- Plot holders are required to wear face masks while at the garden.
- Keep at least 6ft between yourself and other gardeners. Be especially careful when working your plot at the same time as your neighbor and when accessing the water hydrants.
- All communal items must be sprayed with sanitizer **before and after** use. This includes all parts of water hydrants (hoses, handles, etc), gate/door handles, and wheelbarrows. Bottles of sanitizer will be located at the gates, next to water hydrants and within the garden shed.  
**\*\*\*Do not spray the shed lock with sanitizer, this degrades and destroys the lock\*\*\***
- Consider spraying your hands with sanitizer after sanitizing a communal item.
- Do not visit the garden if you are sick. Do not visit the garden if you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 unless you quarantine for 14 days or have a negative Covid-19 test.
